- GPA: 3.0 or above
- Submit a letter of recommendation from her pastor addressing character, church involvement and Christian maturity
- Submit a letter of recommendation from her teacher, counselor or HBA Christian Activities' director(s)
- A letter from the student describing her relationship with Christ, commitment to Christian service and future endeavors

- Determined financial need
- A Christian and an active member of a Christian church
- GPA: 3.0 or above
- Accepted by an accredited university or college
- Submit a letter of recommendation from his or her pastor addressing character, church involvement and Christian maturity
- Submit a letter of recommendation from either a teacher, counselor or HBA staff member who is personally knowledgeable about the student
- A brief one page response to **one** of the following:
 - * Dr. Efurud stated, "The main distinction is the strong belief in a personal experience with God, a personal invitation to bring Christ into your life. It's more of a heart experience than a head experience." Share the importance of your personal experience with God.
 - * Dr. Efurud had "...a voracious appetite for knowledge and a keen mind." Share your quest of being a constant learner.
 - * Dr. Efurud described himself, "I'm not a sprinter, I'm a plodder. I set the course and stay with it." Share how you exemplify steadfastness.
